Eligibility:

All Castle Cove residents who have paid their current neighborhood association annual dues are permitted to use the pool. Guests of Castle Cove residents are welcome at the pool provided their Castle Cove host always accompanies them.

Pool Code:

Entrance to the pool is by an <u>electronic lock</u>. Each residence has its own 4-digit pool code that may be obtained from a Board member. We ask that you do not share your code with anyone and that you do not let anyone "piggyback" through the gates with you except for your non-resident guests (other residents are not guests, they must use their own code). Your code opens both the restroom gate and the tennis gate. The locks record the date and time every code is used. The residents are responsible for the condition of the pool area and the tennis court when your code is used to unlock the gate. Misuse of your code may result in <u>denied</u> access.

Age Restrictions:

Children less than 13 years old must be accompanied by an adult during GUARDED swimming times. Children less than 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult during UNGUARDED swimming times.

Use caution and swim at your own risk.

Swimming Pool Rules

- 1. The Lifeguards control activities within the pool. Swimmers are required to always obey the Lifeguards and Pool Rules. Failure to do so will result in loss of swimming privileges or ejection from the pool.
- 2. No running or horseplay within the pool area.
- 3. The Lifeguard platform chair is off limits to all swimmers. No diving or jumping from or sitting in the lifeguard chair is permitted.
- 4. Backward diving or flips are NOT permitted from the side of the pool.
- 5. Swim wear must be worn by all swimmers. Street clothing, athletic clothing (basketball shorts, running shorts, etc.) and cutoff shorts may not be worn in the pool.
- 6. Children who are not fully "potty trained" must wear swim diapers. DISPOSABLE DIAPERS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE POOL.
- 7. Health department regulations prohibit anyone having infections, communicable diseases, open sores, or wounds from using the pool until the condition has healed.
- 8. There will be hourly adult swim periods for 15 minutes each hour of the day beginning at 50 minutes past the hour. During Adult Swim, only persons 18 years or older and toddlers 2 years old and younger accompanied by an adult may swim. These periods are intended for children to rest, provide personal time for Lifeguards, and permit Lifeguards to perform pool maintenance activities. Children must be seated away from the pool's edge. NO sitting on the edge of the pool, dangling feet, etc. The Lifeguard may extend the adult swim period if children do not obey this rule.
- 9. Flotation devices (inner tubes, rafts, etc.) are permitted in the pool ONLY during adult swim periods. The use of
- 10. "Noodles" during All-Swim periods is at the discretion of the Lifeguards.
- 11. Children requiring the use of swimming aids must be always accompanied by a parent/adult when in the pool.
- 12. No one is to sit next to the Lifeguards or engage in social activities/conversation with Lifeguards when they are performing their lifeguard duties. Lifeguards are employed for the safety and protection of Castle Cove residents and their children. Do not distract the Lifeguards from this important task.
- 13. There is NO SMOKING in the pool area.
- 14. Glass containers are NOT permitted within the pool area.
- 15. Swimmers are not allowed in the pool during inclement weather. The pool will be closed when lightning is sighted, or thunder is heard. The pool will reopen 30 minutes after thunder and/or lightning has ceased.
- 16. The pool will not open if the air temperature at the pool is below 70 degrees Fahrenheit. The pool will open once the temperature rises above 70 degrees.
- 17. No food is allowed in the pool or on the concrete deck surrounding the pool.
- 18. The pool telephone is for outgoing **EMERGENCY CALLS ONLY**.
